## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Hard hats must be worn.
2. Entry Fees: Adults - £22 in advance. £25 on the day.  
Under 16's - £16 in advance £22 on the day.  
Mini Ride (with pedestrian) - £10.  
Entry fees include £2 per rider for Paramedic Support.
3. On Arrival - Riders must report to the Secretary tent and pay the entry fee and any sponsorship monies raised. Horses may start at any time between 10.00am and 1.30pm on the long route. The short route and mini ride is open until 2.00pm. Riders may go in groups.  
**LAST REGISTRATION IS AT 1.15PM.**
4. **All riders must report their return to the Finish Ring or Secretary Tent on completion of the Ride. Riders retiring early must inform one of the Stewards stationed round the course.**
5. The ride mainly takes place on private farmland. Riders are requested to respect the generosity of the landowners and must follow all direction signs and markers.
6. The organisers accept no responsibility for damage to any competitor, persons, horse, vehicles or property whatsoever the cause. Paramedics, a Vet and Farrier will be in attendance.
7. Good riding manners are requested. Please note the ride number of those causing difficulty to others and inform the Stewards on route or at the Secretary Tent.
8. Riders must take care with traffic on public roads and are expected to have their own third-party insurance. Also do not leave horses unattended on the field or on the ride.
9. The decision of the Committee is final.
